Meet ICRI's New Staff!

As smost of you know, ICRI has undergone some major changes. Because of the retirement of Milt and Sally Collins from their position as the management association for ICRI, new management was needed. As of June 1, 2001, Association Concepts (AC) took over as management, and the ICRI offices have been relocated to Des Plaines, IL, a suburb of Chicago. With this move, a whole new staff has been hired.

Kelly Page is serving as the Executive/Technical Director. Kelly, a Fellow of ICRI, has an extensive background in concrete materials. She has worked as an independent sales representative for several repair material companies. She is also very familiar with the inner workings of ICRI, having served as Secretary and as a member of the Board of Directors of ICRI, and as Chairman of their Meetings and Conventions Committee.

Working with Kelly Page out of the Des Plaines location is Chris Jorgensen, Marketing and Chapter Relations Coordinator. Chris comes to ICRI with four years of association management experience, having worked for a trade association for the electronics industry. With that organization, he worked with technical committees on standards, organizing and promoting national conferences and many special projects. He also developed two Web sites, wrote articles for industry trade mag azines and authored and delivered presentations at conferences and trade shows.

As Marketing/Chapter Relations Coordinator, Chris will serve as the chapters' ICRI liaison. He will maintain the lines of communications between ICRI and its chapters, write the Chapter News section of the *Bulletin*, promote new chapter development and assist chapters with special needs. In his marketing role, he is responsible for all ICRI ad sales, including the *Concrete Repair Bulletin*, and the development of marketing programs and

materials to further the organization and its programs. Chris too will be working only for ICRI.

Chris holds a degree in Journalism from Columbia College, Chicago, and last year began his training to become a certified association executive (CAE).

In Farmington Hills, MI (where AC is headquartered), Nickole Honor is ICRI's Member Service Coordinator. She is responsible for all membership issues, publication orders and for any other database inquiries. She reports to Diane Baloh, Director of Member Services for AC. Nickole, a Detroit native, is completing her bachelor degree in e-Commerce at the University of Phoenix. Prior to joining AC and ICRI, Nickole worked at Ford Motor Company as a Communication Analyst. Susan Esper, our Graphic Designer, has been putting together these great looking issues of the *CRB*. She will also be responsible for working with Chris Jorgensen on layouts of all ICRI marketing, such as the Fall Convention Brochure that appears on pages 19-23 of this issue. She reports to Becky Hartford, Manager of Editorial and Production for AC. Susan, originally from Pl ymouth, Michigan, attended Michigan State University and graduated with a Bachelor of Fine Arts (with honors) with an emphasis in Graphic Design. Susan has performed a wide variety of graphic design and publication duties for Scott Publications, World Color, and Holt Graphics.

Association Concepts has also taken over management of ICRI's Web site. John C. Glumb, Managing Director of Information Systems, and his staff, Jason Pennington and Michael Hendricks, have been working diligently to get everything transferred from the previous Web site administrator, and to make sure important sections such as "Chapters" are updated and running properly. They have also been instrumental in setting up the computer system in our Des Plaines office so that we are networked together with the per sonnel in the Farmington Hills office.

The manager of the AC Conventions & Meetings Department is Rénee McAdams. She has named Carole Berrelez ICRI's Meetings and Conventions Coordinator. It may appear that we have an exceptionally large staff, but most of them work only a percentage of their time for ICRI. This is the strength AC brings to ICRI: to have the resources of a large staff while getting the economy of part-time people, as many of them work for more than one association.
